Who are they? These young people are currently supported by **Kanyawegi UK**, (Reg. No. 1106296) a charity set up to provide funds to educate and care for needy orphans in **Kenya**. Around 15 children / young people of different ages are currently being supported by the charity, at all stages of education; some are at primary school, some at secondary; some are in vocational training and others who have aptitude are on higher education courses. In accordance with Kenyan government best practice, all are now supported within their local community / family / extended family, or attending a training course away from home. We no longer have an orphanage building.

Where are they from?..... very deprived backgrounds! Most were at risk in some way; the care and education they now receive is life changing. However, the charity's income has not kept up with expenditure and we need to find additional sponsorship. Every penny received is sent over to Kenya to be spent providing for the children and is managed well and accounted for by our local Manager. For more information, please go to the website:
